Turn to the map and find yourself among the majority of ArtPrize Nines outdoor art installations, as well as such stunning permanent works as Alexander Calder's *La Grand Vitesse*, Mark Di Suvero's iconic tire swing, *Motu Viget*, and Maya Lin's *Ecliptic*; explore the city's groundbreaking architecture, including the world's first LEED Gold Certified art museum, GRAM; and experience the ever-growing cultural entertainment and nightlife options our city has to offer.

artprize 24/7

Outdoor ArtPrize entries are on view 24/7, so you can check them out anytime—day or night—throughout the 19-day event.

art is everywhere

In addition to the 1,346 ArtPrize Nine entries, there is an abundance of public art and architecture in Grand Rapids. Here are just a few that you can also find noted on the map.

- *La Grand Vitesse* by Alexander Calder at Vandenberg (Calder) Plaza is the first public art installation funded by the National Endowment for the Arts. *Motu Viget* by Mark di Suvero is a kinetic art creation, one of the largest tire swings you may ever see.
- *Ecliptic* by Maya Lin, also responsible for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington D.C., is a community amphitheater and ice rink at Rosa Parks Circle.
- *Imagine That!* by Tracy Van Duinen, on the east wall of the Grand Rapids Children's Museum won 2nd place at ArtPrize 2009. The large mural complements another of Van Duinen's mosaics, *Metaphorest*, nearby on the WMCAT building.

- *Fish Ladder* by Joseph Kinnebrew is a functional sculpture designed to help salmon and steelhead navigate upstream around the Sixth Street dam.

bridge street is booming

Just around the corner from the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum is a swiftly growing business and entertainment district that's sure to provide a delicious and festive open, or close, to your ArtPrize visit. Be sure to stop by the five ArtPrize Nine Venues on Bridge Street that include New Holland Brewing Co. The Knickerbocker, The Butcher's Union, O'Toole's Public House, Harmony Hall and Swift Printing Co.

Grand Rapids' food truck scene is on the rise, and the purveyors of mobile munchies will be out in full force at ArtPrize Nine. Stop by Rosa Parks Circle and Ah-Nab-Awen Park for some of the best food truck bites around!
